DESCRIPTION

The *Until Help Arrives* program was developed with the goal of building a continuum of care, including community efforts to be the help, until help arrives.

PART ONE: CURRICULUM

(Thursday, April 16)

The training will be held in two parts. The first part will teach participants the *Until Help Arrives* training including introduction, respond, rescue, report, and survey sections.

The bulk of the training is on the rescue portion. The entire training will last 8 hours.

PREREQUISITE

PART TWO: TEACH BACK

(Monday, April 27)

The second part will require students to teach the *Until Help Arrives* training back to the trainers to ensure they understood key concepts and can communicate those concepts to non-public safety personnel. This session will last 4 hours.
